Chess is a strategy game for two players. The goal is to attack the king of your opponent and put him under control. This means that the king cannot move without being captured. The rules of the game are based on the pieces, half of which are black and half of which are white. True, game makers, who are in the entertainment business, create games with non-traditional colors and replace the typical pieces of play with other characters, but for the purposes of this article, we will use the standard colors. The chessboard has 64 squares alternating the color from black (or dark) to white (or light) on eight rows. Horizontal rows are called ranks and are identified by numbers (from 1 to 8) and vertical rows are files, identified by letters (from A to H). A letter and a number identifies each square. The four squares at the center of the board of directors (Positions E-4, E-5, D-4, D-5) are the most critical in terms of control and winning the game. The player begins with 16 pieces of play, both Black or All White, including eight pawns, two rooks, two knights, two bishops, a king and a queen. Both players put their game pieces on the board in the same order. The way to ensure that the Council is facing the right direction is to remember "Bianco on the right", which means that there should be a white square on your extreme right corner. To make sure to place the pieces in order along the rear rank, it is useful to remember the pieces becomes higher while moving inwards. Rooks, or the pieces that look like a castle, go into the corners; Knights, the pieces that look like horses, occupy the space next to the rook; And the two bishops sit on the squares within the Knights. You have two spaces and two pieces left. Remember, the queen always goes her color alone. An intelligent way to remember this rule is that a "dress of the queen must always match her shoes". Each of the eight squares in the next row or ranking holds a pawn. The chess goal is to capture the opposing king, but since actually catching the king is against the rules of the game, players aim to checkmate. Do you sound confused? It's - at first. Think of the game as a battle. All your pieces work to capture or remove the pieces of your opponent from the board by moving on the squares they occupy. Capturing his pieces, his king becomes more vulnerable and open to attack. Meanwhile, you also have to defend your king and save your pieces to be captured. This is where the strategy comes into play. When you have your pieces in a position where your next move would be to catch the opposing king (if allowed), you have it under control. Now your opponent has to make a move to save his king or take him out of control. If the king is trapped and has no way to escape, it is called checkmate and you won each Piece is assigned points, and there are rules on how it can move to the board. The value of the point assigned to each piece is only to show its strength in terms of how it can move. At the end of the game there is no addition of points based on the pieces you captured. The winner is declared because he or she trapped the opposing king, in other words he was put at checkmat. Chess is a game for everyone and easier than you can think. The other pieces are free to move through the IL Set in the following ways: bishops can move in any diagonal direction in an unlimited number of chess spaces available. Rooks can do the same, but in any direction not diagonally on the chessboard. In Chess, Queens (your most valuable piece of chess) can move in any direction in an unlimited number of available spaces. Kings can move in any direction, however, only one square at a time on the chessboard. In the chess, once the king is threatened, he is placed in "signs". The player with the king in danger must use the next move to move it to the chessboard, attack the pieces of the threatening chess or block it to exit the "control". Otherwise, what might signal the end of the chess game with the king in "checkmate", which means that it is impossible to avoid an attack on the king and the player who puts the king in this position wins the game of online chess. - The first chess configuration with light and dark alternating squares was used in Europe in 1090. - In Chess, the term "checkmate" comes from the Persian phrase "Shah Mat", meaning "the king is dead".
